OCCUPATIONS

In the tables OCCUPATIONCOU_IR, OCCUPATIONCOU_NI, INDUSTRYOCCCOU_IR, and INDUSTRYOCCCOU_NI, the data is organized so that there are separate columns for each sex and each county. The unique key for the rows of these tables is therefore the particular occupation and the year. These tables are relatively small and manageable. However, they are not relational in the sense that they do not have a column in common with the other tables in the database which hold county-level data.

In addition to the county codes, the occupations tables have an additional coding scheme for the occupations themselves. This has been devised so that users interested in particular types of occupations or industrial classifications may narrow the field to general categories before drawing information out of the tables. At the same time, the tables are constructed so that the exact text of the original source is preserved. In addition, the order in which occupations are listed in the census is also preserved.

This coding and organization is found in the following columns common to all the occupations tables: SEQUENCE, GROUP_1, GROUP_2, NAME, and YEAR. NAME is the exact title of the occupation given in each source. The SEQUENCE column numbers the rows of data from each source according to the order in which the particular NAME appears. GROUP_2 gives the exact title of the outline headings under which each NAME appears in the original source. The user may re-establish the organizational scheme of the source table by sorting the column SEQUENCE. GROUP_1 gives a coding scheme which attempts to amalgamate the GROUP_2 organizational schemes from all sources in the table. The codes used in GROUP_2 are held in the database table CODE_OCC. The scheme follows the traditional three sector analysis of the economy: PR = primary products, LM = light manufacturing, HM = heavy manufacturing, SS = service sector. The contents of the table CODE_OCC are reproduced on the following page for convenience.
