

## 4491 - Parish Register Aggregate Analyses

*This document has been created by AHDS History*

### Introduction

These data formed the basis of a reconstruction of English population history from the sixteenth to the nineteenth century, published as *The population history of England, 1541-1871: a reconstruction* (1981) by E.A. Wrigley and R.S. Schofield.

The 'original' study was completed in the late 1970s. In the early 1990s, under the auspices of Local Population Studies, it was re-packaged as a series of spreadsheets, and published as such. Each parish was represented by 10 spreadsheets, which between them recorded:

- original monthly and annual totals of births, deaths and marriages;
- a 'corrected' version of this data;
- monthly seasonality indexes by half-century;
- 'crisis' information concerning periods of epidemic mortality crisis in each parish, and the severity of the epidemic.

In 2002 AHDS History received a grant from the ESRC (RES-479-26-4003) to re-aggregate the data. During this re-aggregation, each parish was given an identification number, allowing its integration with Kain and Oliver's *Historic Parishes of England and Wales: an Electronic Map of Boundaries before 1850 with a Gazetteer and Metadata*.<sup>1</sup>

A revised version of the end of grant report is located within this folder.

This study is now comprised of four files; "events", "eve\_idx", "crises" and "par\_char". The remainder of this document describes each file in turn and the variables contained within each file or table

**TABLE: events****VARIABLE: RECID**

Description: uniquely identifies each record in the 'events' table. Variable added by AHDS History.

**VARIABLE: PARNAM**

Description: identifies each parish in the sample. Note, this variable alone does not uniquely identify parishes. Parishes named Hadleigh, Wymondham and Wootton occur in more than one county. Hadleigh in Essex and Suffolk; Wymondham in Leicestershire and Norfolk and Wootton in Bedfordshire and Oxfordshire.

**VARIABLE: COUNTY**

Description: identifies the county for each parish in the sample.

**VARIABLE: HPEWCODE**

Description: numeric identifier for each parish as given in R. J. Cain and R. Oliver, *Historic parishes of England and Wales* (Colchester, HDS, 2001). Variable added by AHDS History.

**VARIABLE: YEAR**

Description: the year of the event

**VARIABLE: MONTH\_NO**

Description: the month number for the event, e.g., 1 is January, 2 is February, etc.

**VARIABLE: BAP**

Description: the corrected number of baptisms for that period.

**VARIABLE: MAR**

Description: the corrected number of marriages for that period.

**VARIABLE: BUR**

Description: the corrected number of burials for that period.

**VARIABLE: BAPORIG**

Description: the original number of baptisms for that period.

**VARIABLE: MARORIG**

Description: the original number of marriages for that period.

**VARIABLE: BURORIG**

Description: the original number of burials for that period.

This table gives index values of the various events.

**VARIABLE: RECID**

Description: uniquely identifies each record in the 'eve\_idx' table. Variable added by AHDS History.

**VARIABLE: PARNAM**

Description: identifies each parish in the sample. Note, this variable alone does not uniquely identify parishes. Parishes named Hadleigh, Wymondham and Wootton occur in more than one county. Hadleigh in Essex and Suffolk; Wymondham in Leicestershire and Norfolk and Wootton in Bedfordshire and Oxfordshire.

**VARIABLE: COUNTY**

Description: identifies the county for each parish in the sample.

**VARIABLE: HPEWCODE**

Description: numeric identifier for each parish as given in R. J. Cain and R. Oliver, *Historic parishes of England and Wales* (Colchester, HDS, 2001). Variable added by AHDS History.

**VARIABLE: PERIOD**

Description: the 50 year period to which the index number applies.

**VARIABLE: MONTH**

Description: the month for the event

**VARIABLE: BAPINDEX**

Description: an index number for baptisms in the particular month for the whole fifty year period under observation. A value of 100 would represent an even distribution of baptisms for any month, "based on a uniform rate with no seasonal pattern at all". (See R. Schofield, *Parish Register Aggregate Analyses: the Population history of England database and introductory guide* (Local Population Studies, Colchester, 1998), p.5.) Thus a value of 120 would represent baptisms running at 20 per cent above the average rate over the whole half century.

**VARIABLE: MARINDEX**

Description: an index number for marriages in the particular month for the whole fifty year period under observation. For further details see bapindex above.

**VARIABLE: BURINDEX**

Description: an index burials for marriages in the particular month for the whole fifty year period under observation. For further details see bapindex above.

**VARIABLE: MONTH\_NO**

Description: the month number for the event, e.g., 1 is January, 2 is February, etc.

**TABLE: Crises**

This table contains summary information of periods of crisis or epidemic mortality in each parish. For further details see: See R. Schofield, *Parish Register Aggregate Analyses: the Population history of England database and introductory guide* (Local Population Studies, Colchester, 1998), p.5-6.

**VARIABLE: RECID**

Description: uniquely identifies each record in the 'crises' table. Variable added by AHDS History.

**VARIABLE: PARNAM**

Description: identifies each parish in the sample. Note, this variable alone does not uniquely identify parishes. Parishes named Hadleigh, Wymondham and Wootton occur in more than one county. Hadleigh in Essex and Suffolk; Wymondham in Leicestershire and Norfolk and Wootton in Bedfordshire and Oxfordshire.

**VARIABLE: COUNTY**

Description: identifies the county for each parish in the sample.

**VARIABLE: HPEWCODE**

Description: numeric identifier for each parish as given in R. J. Cain and R. Oliver, *Historic parishes of England and Wales* (Colchester, HDS, 2001). Variable added by AHDS History.

**VARIABLE: STARTYEA**

Description: the year in which this period of crisis mortality commenced. To be used in conjunction with startmon.

**VARIABLE: STARTMON**

Description: the month in which this period of crisis mortality commenced. To be used in conjunction with startyear.

**VARIABLE: ENDYEA**

Description: the year in which this period of crisis mortality finished. To be used in conjunction with endmon.

**VARIABLE: ENDMONTH**

Description: the month in which this period of crisis mortality finished. To be used in conjunction with endyear.

**VARIABLE: PEAKYEA**

Description: the year in which the peak mortality was recorded. To be used in conjunction with peakmont.

**VARIABLE: PEAKMONT**

Description: the month in which the peak mortality was recorded. To be used in conjunction with peakyear.

**VARIABLE: DURATION**

Description: the duration of the crisis recorded in complete months.

**VARIABLE: SRPEAK**

Description: the ratio of the number of burials in the *maximum* month of the crisis to the *normal* number of burials. The normal number is a forecast for that month on the basis of mortality before the epidemic commenced.

**VARIABLE: SRTOTAL**

Description: a ratio similar to srpeak calculated for the whole of the epidemic period.

Note: "The epidemics listed here were identified ... [by a] measure of probability that the numbers of burials recorded in any month, or sequence of months, were too great to have arisen by chance given the normal, endemic, levels of mortality". (R. Schofield, Parish Register Aggregate Analyses: the Population history of England database and introductory guide (Local Population Studies, Colchester, 1998), p.6.)

Description: uniquely identifies each record

**VARIABLE: COUNTY**

Description: the name of each county as reported by R. Schofield, *Parish Register Aggregate Analyses: the Population history of England database and introductory guide* (Local Population Studies, Colchester, 1988).

**VARIABLE: EAST**

Description: the easterly position of the parish according to Ordnance Survey Maps 1:63, 360 (1946- edition).

**VARIABLE: NORTH**

Description: the northerly position of the parish according to Ordnance Survey Maps 1:63, 360 (1946- edition).

**VARIABLE: CHURCH**

Description: the coded variable church indicates whether the parish church is within the settlement or not. The codes were added by AHDS History.
