1. WhoHere

Who normally lives at this address?

Press <1> to continue

2. Name

Enter the preferred title of the respondent

3. FstNme

Enter the first name of the respondent

APPLIES TO ALL

4. SurNme

Enter the surname of the respondent

Student nurses living in NHS accommodation should be coded as living at a 'private address'.

Code first that applies

What is your date of birth?

For day not given... enter 15 for day
For month not given... enter 6 for month

10. AgeIf

What was your age last birthday?
98 or more = Code 97

APPLIES IF: (DteofBth = DONTKNOW) OR (DteofBth = REFUSAL)

11. HallRes

Record only

Interviewer - record if this person is one of those you recorded as living away from home.

- (1) Yes
- (2) No

12. xMarSta

Ask or record

Are you currently ...

Running prompt - Code first that applies

- (1) single, that is never married,
- (2) married and living with your husband/wife,
- (3) a civil partner in a legally-recognised Civil Partnership,
- (4) married and separated from your husband/wife,
- (5) divorced,
- (6) or widowed?
- (7) Spontaneous only - In a legally-recognised Civil Partnership and separated from his/her civil partner
- (8) Spontaneous only - Formerly a civil partner, the Civil Partnership now legally dissolved
- (9) Spontaneous only - A surviving civil partner: his/her partner having since died

Ask or record

16.HiHNum

You have told me that...jointly own or rent the accommodation. Which of them/who has the highest income from earnings, benefits, pensions and any other sources?

Enter person number - if two or more joint householders have the same income, enter 17
